MONTPELLIER HISTORIC CENTRE

A town that continues to bear the marks of time and proudly displays the symbols of eras past. Strolling through the historic centre is to embark on a voyage across a thousand years of history, from the founding of the town in 985 to the present day and beyond. SAINT-GUILHEM LE DÉSERT

One of France's most beautiful villages and a spiritual stopover on the road to Compostela, medieval Saint-Guilhem-le-Désert is a veritable haven of peace. From Place de la Liberté and its impressive 150 year old plane tree, the village streets wind their way through charming houses with Renaissance mullioned windows, gemelled bays and Gothic lintels.

ODYSSEUM OUARTER

At the edge of town is Odysseum, a unique open-air leisure and shopping concept with at its centre a twentieth-century square (known as Place des Grands Hommes) and the Hélios Theatre with its statues. You will also find restaurants, boutiques and department stores, as well as leisure pursuits such as cinema, bowling, aquarium, skating, climbing, and more.
